

PUNGGL Pinot Grigio

Orange, honey and hay accompany the zesty and fruity aromas of our Pinot Grigio. The body and juicy structure coming from deep clay soils, and the long finish fashioned by the aged vines, make this wine a great companion to intensely flavored starters, fish and white meats.

At a mere 82-feet high the vineyard called Punggl, meaning hill in South Tyrolean dialect, is characterized by its warm temperatures. It was formed from clay-based sands in the south of Margreid and is home to 80-year-old Pinot Grigio vines.
